THS (TPS) ATTENDANCE POLICY OVERVIEW (TPS Policy #6006)

EXCUSED ABSENCE:

An absence is considered excused if <u>WRITTEN</u> documentation* describing the reason for the absence is received by the school <u>within 10 days</u> of the student's return to school, **AND** the absence meets the following criteria:

- <u>Absences 1-9</u> may be excused when a <u>parent</u> submits written documentation (*emails and text messages do NOT constitute written documentation)
- <u>10+ absences</u> may only be excused with written documentation as follows:
 - o Student illness with verification from a qualified medical professional
 - o Religious holiday
 - o Mandatory court appearance (by the student)
 - o Funeral, death in the family, or other family emergency
 - Extraordinary educational opportunity <u>pre-approved</u> by district administrators – NOTE: family vacations do <u>NOT</u> qualify as extraordinary educational opportunities
 - o Lack of transportation normally provided by the school district

Determination of whether an absence is excused or not will be made by the building principal (or his/her designee)

TRUANT:

A student ages 5-18 years old is considered truant if they have 4 unexcused absences in any 1 month <u>OR</u> 10 unexcused absences in any school year.

EXCESSIVE ABSENCES:

EXCESSIVE ABSENCES WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF CREDIT AT THE HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL.

"Excessive" is defined as:

- 5 or more unexcused absences in a semester course; OR
- 10 or more unexcused absences in a full year course
